

## Personal Pronouns as the Subject



 A subject noun is who or what the sentence is about. The subject noun does the action.

ENGLISH LEAR

- A subject pronoun takes the place of a subject noun in a sentence.
- We use subject pronouns to make the sentence shorter.

#### Singular Personal Pronouns

Singular personal pronouns represent a single person or thing.



I: the person doing the speaking.



You: the person being

spoken directly to.



He: a single boy.



She: a single girl.



It: to a single thing.




#### Plural Personal Pronouns

Plural personal pronouns refer to more than one person or thing.



They: more than one boy, girl, or thing.



We: the person doing the speaking and others.




#### Writing an Email

- An email is like a letter: it usually has a greeting, body, and closing line.




### Don't and Doesn't



- They help students begin, connect, and end their message clearly.
- These are often short, common sentences that students can remember and reuse.

- Common phrases and expressions are:

  - Opening: How are you? / I hope you are well.
  - Feelings: I miss you. / I'm excited to write to you.
  - Closing: Please write back soon.

## Question words

- Question words are words we use to ask questions. They help us get specific information about something.
- Each question word has a different purpose.

Who

Used to ask about a person.

Example: Who is coming to the party?

What

Used to ask about a thing, an idea, or an action.

Examples: What is your favourite colour?

What are you doing?

Where

Used to ask about a place or location.

Example: Where do you live?

When

Used to ask about time.

Example: When is the movie starting?

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Why

Used to ask about a reason.

Example: Why are you sad?

Each word has its own purpose and will receive a different answer.


